

NON-LICENSED WORK REFRESHER THE CONTROL OF ASBESTOS REGULATIONS 2012

The Control of Asbestos Regulations 2012, since November 2006, include the duty that employers shall provide appropriate training for all workers who are likely to be exposed to asbestos. The Regulations include three levels of training which should be given to employees, this includes; training for non-licensable asbestos work, persons requiring this type of training would include those whose work will knowingly disturb ACMs, such as maintenance workers, refurbishment workers and their supervisors.

The Regulations require any persons who work with asbestos to refresh their training at least every 12 months. This course is only available to those who have been previously trained to work with non-licensed ACM's.

The following is a list of subjects that may be covered in the ½ day training session in non-licensable works (the course content is determined by the use of a training needs analysis, and may include some of the content listed below):

- Asbestos Awareness (Previously obtained within the past 6 months)
- Emergency procedures (EM1)
- Use of a Class H Vacuum (EM4)
- Control measures used on site for dust suppression (EM5)
- Use and selection of the correct PPE and RPE (EM6)
- Cleaning down the work area (EM7)
- Decontamination (EM8)
- Correct waste handling on site (EM9)
- Practical Training, Use of PPE, Control Measures, Decontamination etc.

The course can be held at your own premises; the maximum number of delegates we recommend is 12 per session
